

Cognitive & Educational Assessment

CatholicCare Victoria psychologists and provisional psychologists can administer cognitive assessments, including the Wechsler Intelligence Scales for Children (WISC-V, WPPSI-IV & WAIS-IV) and the Wechsler Individual Achievement Test (WIAT-III).

Adaptive assessment using the Vineland Adaptive Behaviour Scales (Vineland-3) is also available when applicable.

Other investigative behavioural checklists and assessments may also be suggested if appropriate.



WHAT'S INVOLVED

- Cognitive assessments identify strengths and weaknesses in specific cognitive domains including verbal and visual problem-solving, working memory and processing speed.
- Educational assessments focus on individual academic skills such as reading comprehension, decoding, mathematical problem-solving, written expression, and oral language abilities
- Assessments will assist in understanding children's learning and behavioural needs, guiding learning and other supports, applying for funding, and informing diagnosis if appropriate.
